A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

Our top priority remains saving the lives of unborn babies and then educating their moms and dads as to how to make healthy and wise decisions regarding childrearing and day-to-day living.

With the help of approximately 30 weekly volunteers, our staff of 14 provided 232 new mothers and babies and over 200 returning families with 3,165 client visits this past year. Our free services include a 24-hot line, community classes, "Learn-to-Earn" educational opportunities, private and group counseling sessions, thousands of practical and necessary safety items for pregnant moms and their little ones, and an emergency pantry for those most in need. Those visiting Tri-City Life Center will find an inviting and homey atmosphere with client assistants and counselors who accept them unconditionally.

Our community outreach includes presenting "the unExpected" program to hundreds of teens in middle and high school. The program is designed to **Encourage, Empower, Equip and Educate** teens in making healthy choices. The student and teacher evaluations consistently rate this program as above average in content and practicality.

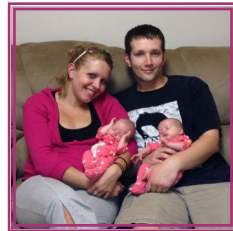

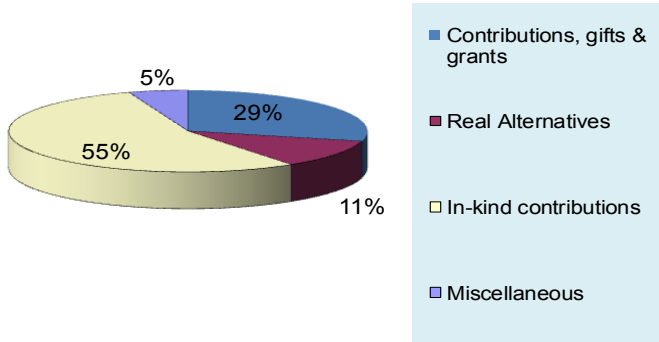
